#### **Payments**

Just a reminder that all payments to the school are via ParentPay, this enables you to control and manage your money for your child/ren. Please log in to your account regularly to keep update with payments. This does not apply to donations such as non-uniform days/bake sales, this will remain a cash donation. Those with high debts will be sent home with a debt letter and if balances are still outstanding, further action will be made.

#### ParentPay—SET UP

All children have their own account, with their own unique username and password, once activated and registered, you have control of any payments. ParentPay allows you to make payments via your credit or debit Card. If you require an activation letter, please request at the school office.

### **PayPoint**

If you wish to pay with cash, you can make payments via a PayPoint shop such as supermarkets, petrol stations and any other shop with the PayPoint logo. If you wish to use this method, speak to the school office and request a PayPoint barcode letter, where there will be instructions on how to pay for the individual payment item.
