Using a simple magic badge or Emoji password, your child will logon once to access multiple applications that we use in school, including Times Table Rock Stars; Numbots and Google Classroom to name just a few!

Your child's magic badge and Emoji password can be found in their reading record. If your child has lost their reading record or you cannot find their login details, please contact the school office.


In the event of any future school closure, teaching will take place via the virtual classroom. For this reason, it is vital that we are aware of any issues with logging on to the virtual classroom at home. A short parent survey will be sent out soon to gather this information.

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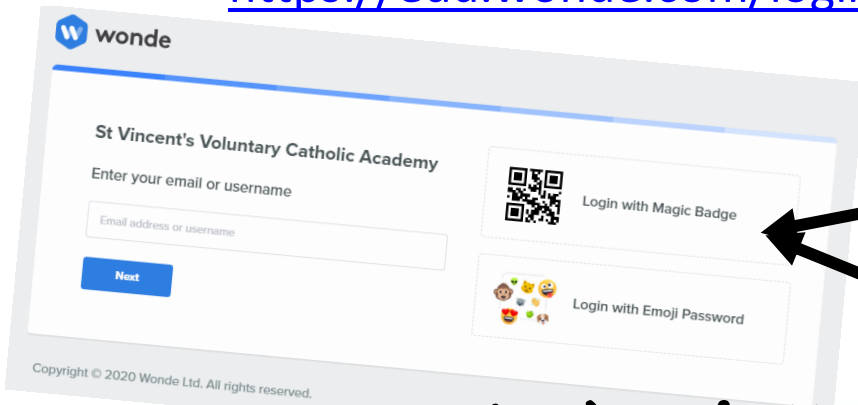

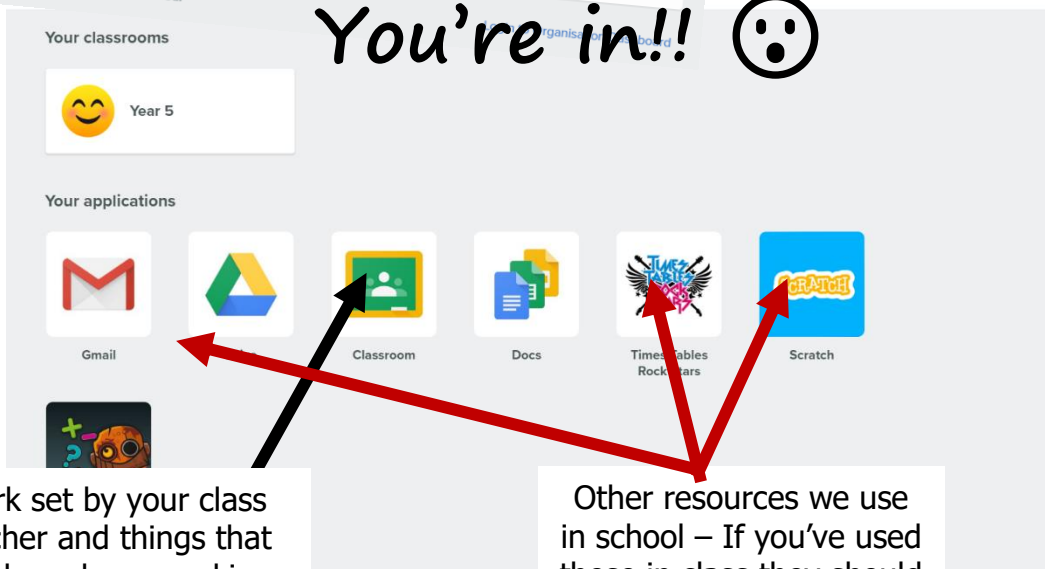
